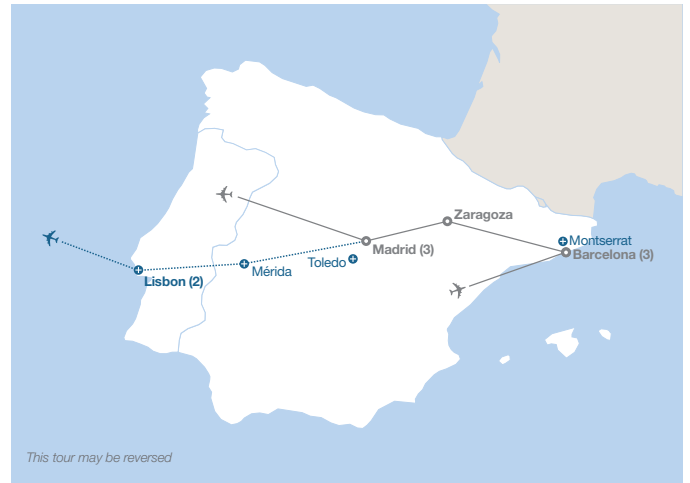

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Spain

Day 2: Barcelona

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Barcelona, an art lover's dream city and the place where masters like Miró, Picasso and Dalí flourished. During your stay you'll explore open-air plazas dotted with avant-garde gems, like the Plaza de Catalunya and Plaza España. Snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Família and the landscaped greenery and playful Modernist mosaics of Park Güell. Flower vendors and street performers greet you as you walk the tree-lined Las Ramblas.
- Take a walking tour of Barcelona: Las Ramblas.

Day 3: Barcelona

- Visit Park Güell.
- Visit La Sagrada Família.
- Time to see more of Barcelona or [explore Barcelona by bike](#).

Day 4: Barcelona

- Take an expert-led walking tour of Barcelona: Barrio Gótico; Barcelona Cathedral.
- Time to see more of Barcelona or [visit Montserrat](#).

Day 5: Zaragoza | Madrid

- Travel via Zaragoza to Madrid, the capital and largest city in Spain. While here you'll explore Puerta del Sol, the heart of the city, and travel back in time to Spain's Golden Age at Plaza Mayor, where you'll learn about this grand square's history of bullfights, royal weddings and public executions. At the Prado, behold paintings like Velázquez's *Las Meninas* and Goya's paired canvases. Get a taste of royal Madrid at the extravagant Palacio Real, where you'll wander the fabulous palace interior and find more than 2,000 rooms decked in beautiful frescoes, delicate porcelain wares, and finely woven rugs.

Day 6: Madrid

- Take an expert-led tour of Madrid: Puerta del Sol; Plaza Mayor.
- Visit the Palacio Real.
- Participate in a flamenco dance lesson and attend a show. Feel the beat this evening as you experience flamenco, the fiery dance full of Spanish soul. Born of Indian, Moorish, Arabian, and gypsy influences. Flamenco is characterized by intricate footwork and clapping displays. During your lesson, your instructor will demonstrate basic techniques and describe flamenco's history and origins. Then, let the classical guitar be your guide and try it out yourself. Later, watch bonafide flamenco artists in action during a special performance. The impressive adornments worn by many dancers match the passionate rhythm of the dance itself—their colorful costumes and dramatic ruffles are sure to dazzle.

Day 7: Madrid

- Take a walking tour of Madrid.
- Visit the Prado.
- Time to see more of Madrid or [visit Toledo](#).

Day 8: Depart for home

Day 9: Lisbon

- Take an expert-led tour of Lisbon.

- Visit Mosteiro dos Jerónimos.
- Take a walking tour of Lisbon.
