

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Thailand

Day 2: Bangkok

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Bangkok, home of gleaming silver skyscrapers, ancient jewelbox temples, and serene Buddhist monasteries. While here, you'll see how ancient traditions govern the behavior of a modern people, and how the timeless merges with the contemporary. Experience this enduring and spirited culture on a boat ride along the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi *klongs* (canals), where ornate homes and gilded temples once earned Bangkok the name "Venice of the East."

Day 3: Bangkok

- Take an expert-led tour of Bangkok.
- Take a boat tour of the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi *klongs*.
- See Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn).
- Visit Wat Pho (Temple of the Reclining Buddha), which is covered entirely in precious gold.
- Explore the Museum of Siam, an interactive museum that depicts Thai history and culture.
- View the sunset from Wat Saket (Golden Mountain Temple).

Day 4: Ayutthaya | Bangkok

- Take a tour around the UNESCO-recognized historic city of Ayutthaya. During the tour, stop for a sweet local treat.
- Return to Bangkok by boat.

Day 5: Ratchaburi | Kanchanaburi

- Travel to Ratchaburi.
- Visit the Damnoen Saduak floating market.
- Travel to Kanchanaburi.
- Visit the Death Railway Museum, dedicated to the victims of the Death Railway Bridge. The museum houses displays on the history of the railway, as well as detailed descriptions of the lives of the prisoners who built the line.
- Enjoy a free evening or
 - ⊕ participate in a Thai cooking class.

Day 6: Kanchanaburi

- Travel to the Saiyoke Yai Waterfall and National Park. Naturalists love the deep, blue winged pittas, limestone wren-babblers, wild pigs, and tiny Kittie's hog-nosed bats that inhabit the dense deciduous forest around the waterfall.
- Stop at the Hell Fire Pass Memorial in Burma.
- Experience a train ride on the "Death Railway."

Day 7: Kanchanaburi | Phitsanulok

- Travel via Suphanburi to Nakhon Sawan.
- Visit the 100-year-old Sam Chuk market.
- Travel to Phitsanulok.
- Enjoy a free evening or
 - ⊕ take an evening rickshaw ride through the market.

Day 8: Sukhothai | Chiang Mai

- Visit the Sukhothai Historical Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the nation's spiritual center. You'll have the option to take a bike ride around the temples after the tour.
- Travel to Chiang Mai via San Kamphaeng and Bor Sang.
- Stop for a silk-weaving and paper umbrella-painting demonstration.

Day 9: Mae Taeng Valley | Chiang Mai

- Visit the Mae Taeng Valley and the Elephant Nature Park.
- Enjoy a Khan Toke dinner and show.

Day 10: Chiang Mai | Bangkok

- Visit the Wat Phra That Doi Suthep temple.
- Participate in a group discussion with local monks.
- Fly back to Bangkok.

Day 11: Depart for home

Days 11-12: Cha-Am

- Travel to Cha-Am.
- Enjoy free time on the beach or
 - ⊕ visit the Kaeng Krachan National Park.

Day 13: Cha-Am | Bangkok

- Explore on your own.
- Return to Bangkok.
